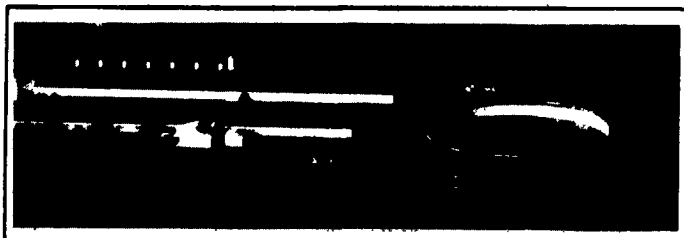


CONFINEMENT STALLS

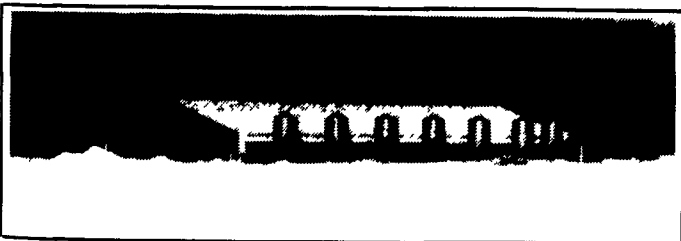

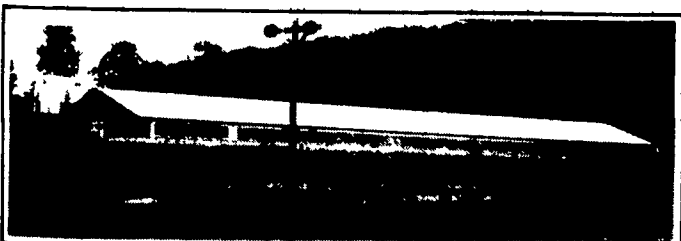
300 Sow Farrow - Feeder Pig Unit



1200 Sow Farrow-Feeder Pig Unit



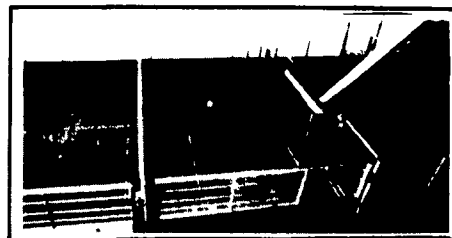
2800 HP Offsite Nursery (7 Rooms)

NURSERY PENNING
Nursery penning has been improved by the use of an optional solid stainless steel panel on the front gates which keeps walkways clean. Stainless steel feet on penning eliminate corrosion where penning attaches to the floor. Stainless steel drinker pipes & mounting brackets also increase durability.

FINISHING PENNING
Standard stainless steel feet and fasteners offer improved durability over other similar types of penning. Loop and flipper latch arrangement eliminates the use of drop pins. Stainless steel fence line feeders provide excellent durability and a minimum of waste.
