The specialist notes that a significant number of accidents occur with lightweight chain saws that are used primarily by homeowners. Making sure your saw is in good operating order and using proper personal protective gear are the first steps toward safety. Jester offers the following tips to help prevent needless accidents:

- · Thoroughly read the owner's manual
- · Know your chain saw and its limitations
- · Maintain the saw according to the manufacturer's recommenda-
