PASA presented Keene with its
 1994 Pennsylvania Sustainable
 Agriculture Award "for a lifetime
 of visionary dedication to the con-
 servation of our natural resources
 and for leading the way to a more
 sustainable agriculture."

Keene founded Walnut Acres
 Organic Farms in 1946. The farm,
 located near the central Pennsyl-
 vania village of Penns Creek re-
 mains a family operation and now
 includes a grain mill, bakery, can-
 nery, and farm store. Walnut
 Acres products are sold via mail
 order and in natural foods stores
 throughout the United States.

With Keene as its agriculture
 visionary, Walnut Acres has al-
 ways followed strict organic farm-
 ing and food preparation prac-
 tices. No synthetic chemicals are
 used at any step, from growing to
 final packaging. In addition, a pri-
 mary emphasis is placed on build-
 ing up the soil — putting more
 back in than is taken out.

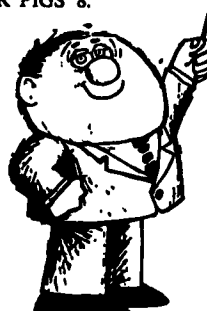
PASA, in making its second an-

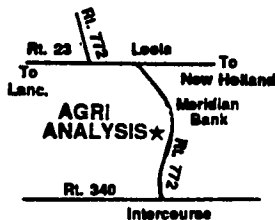
