SUMMARY

Compared to last week: Feeder steers steady to \$1.00 higher; feeder heifers steady to \$1.00 lower. Few stocker cattle steady. Demand moderate to good and somewhat improved from last week. Trade moderately active. Supply primarily feeder cattle off graze-out wheat. Quality plain to average, few attractive. Weigh-ups mostly average. Flesh conditions of feeders highly varied from slightly thin to mainly fleshy. Slaughter cows steady to \$.75 lower, decline on fleshy cows. Slaughter bulls \$1.50 lower. Demand very good for cows. Receipts this week 13,600; last week 16,323; last year 12,209. Supply consisted of 89 percent yearlings over 600 lbs.; 7 percent calves and stockers under 600 lbs.; 4 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.


