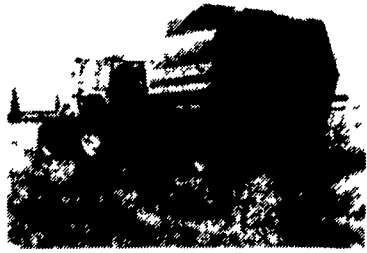


# Bale It Wet Or Dry

CARLISLE (Cumberland Co.) — Vicon/Greenland has introduced RV 116 and RV 126 Variable Chamber Round Balers with the versatility to bale silage, hay, and straw.

Both models produce a dense, uniform 4-foot wide package. Bale diameters can be tailored from 2 feet to 4 feet 3 inches on the RV 116 and from 2 feet to 6 feet on the RV 126 to suit individual crops and conditions.

A twin belt system and "open throat" stuffing chamber combine for instant, trouble-free bale core formation. Even thin, short material starts to roll immediately on contact with two independent sets of belts running in opposite direc-

tions. Density can be controlled from the beginning (by springs), to the end (hydraulically), of the

bale-making process, eliminating hard cores in the bale center.

Hydraulically tensioned belts maintain constant pressure as the bale forms. The result is a firm, consistently dense package that retains its shape for safe storage and handling. Grasses ensile better with less air. Bales unroll completely for feeding. Customizing bale density to fit virtually any crop — from high moisture hay to straw — is a simple turn of a knob. A bale shape indicator and warning lights make it even easier to produce a perfect bale every time.

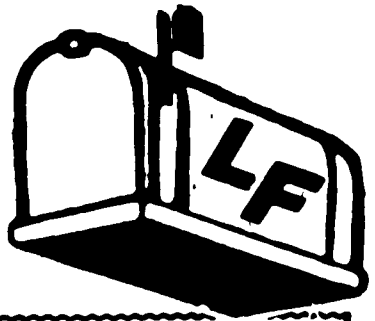
