Science, along with other extension specialists are planning a one-day satellite program which is scheduled for June 2. This program, called "Dairy On-Farm Problem-Solving: The Process" will provide a continuing education opportunity to those persons who advise dairy producers at the farm level. This includes farm consultants, county extension agents, feed company representatives and veterinarians.

The purpose of this program is to introduce ag-professionals to a systematic approach when identifying, quantifying, and developing responses to on-farm problems. This program will provide introductory techniques in problem-solving. Participants will be encouraged to expand their thinking and work cooperatively with other ag-professionals when examining farm problems.

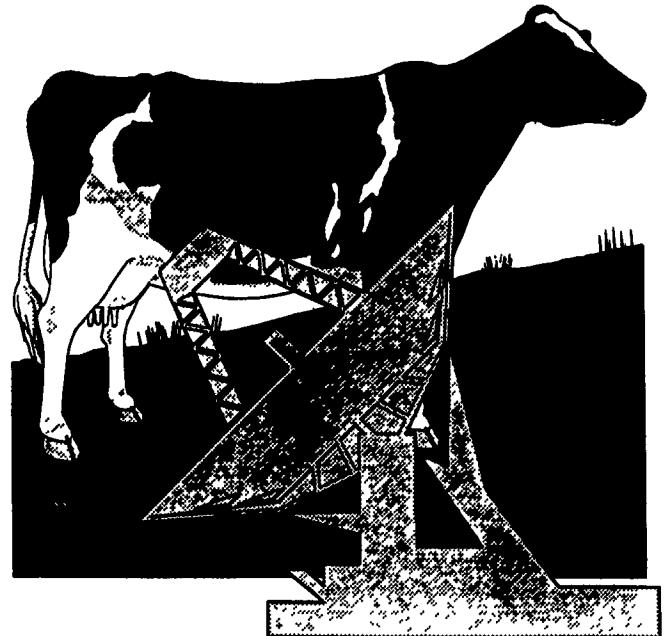
The program will be divided into five segments. The problem-solving process will be the foundation in which additional information, including records, facilities, animal inspection, and feed delivery systems, will be based. Practice activities will allow for an opportunity to apply these

principles. A visit to a local dairy farm will also facilitate hands-on experience. Time will be available for question and answer periods.

Penn State is charging \$25 to cover the cost of the seminar notebook. Some down-link sites will have a local registration charge to cover lunch, and transportation costs to and from the farm.

Several regional county extension offices will support this program by hosting down-link sites within Pennsylvania, New York and New Jersey. Contact the down-link site coordinator to register at the down-link site closest to you.
