monella prorblem. It started last year as a pilot program.

"And we doing the majority of the culturing of the environmental samples and egg samples in the three diagnostic labs. They've supported us.

"The federal government, the USDA, has supported us to some extent, but they're going to back off slowly, and we're going to have to pick up this support from in the state from the laboratory system and the industry itself.

"So, it's a joint program," he said.

The cooperative construction of an integrated system is getting into many aspects,

according to Card.

"When we have the Johne's meeting, we're really trying to talk about some coordination between states and regions as we do with Cornell now, we don't have too many.

"Virginia and Maryland have syustems that we can coordinate with, and New Jersey can do some things that we can take advantage of.

"So, if New Jersey has a good test system for Potomac Horse Fever, which they do, then we might as well send our samples to New Jersey and have them do it, because they have the expertise, the cost is right and so forth.

"We send stuff all over the country to people that we realize have a greater capability to or a more effective testing procedure lets say, and pay for it, then to try to set up a new systems. We do, however, need the basic expertise and guidelines. And that's what we're developing, I think.

"I think by the end of another two years, we will be in fairly good shape."


