**OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY:** Compared to last week: Stocker and feeder cattle steady after a cautious opening. Few steer and heifer calves \$1.00-\$2.00 lower with new crops beginning to appear. Demand moderate to good with fairly active trading. Weigh-ups ranged from gaunt to full and were worse for buyers than last weeks gaunter conditions which was caused by cool wet weather. Flesh conditions also deteriorated from last week with feeders ranging from slightly thin to many fleshy. Slaughter cows steady to \$1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls steady to \$1.00 lower. Receipts this week 11,050; last week 9,334; last year 7,564. Supply consisted of 90 percent yearlings and stockers over 600 lbs.; 8 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 2 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
