Weigh-ups ranged from gaunt to full and were worse for buyers than last weeks saunter conditions which was caused by cool wet weather. Flesh conditions also deteriorated from last week with feeders ranging from slightly thin to many fleshy. Slaughter cows steady to \$1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls steady to \$1.00 lower. Receipts this week 11,050; last week 9,334; last year 7,564. Supply consisted of 90 percent yearlings and stockers over 600 lbs.; 8 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 2 percent cows and bulls. 


