

Coverts Training Project Planned

COLLEGE PARK, Md. — Woodland owners, managers, and others interested in forest and wildlife management can apply to attend a free training workshop on October 6-9 at the Shepherd's Spring retreat and conference center near Sharpsburg in Washing-

ton County.

The workshop is part of an ongoing outreach and training program called the Coverts Project, which is sponsored by the Cooperative Extension Service—University of Maryland at College Park and the Ruffed Grouse

Society.

The project gets its name from thickets that provide a sheltered habitat for wildlife.

Thirty individuals will be chosen for this year's Coverts workshop, which focuses on general forestry and wildlife management

principles. The workshop demonstrates how good forest management can make wildlife more abundant, healthy and diverse.

In return for free training, reference materials and followup seminars, the participants — dubbed "Coverts Cooperators" — will be asked to establish a sound forest and wildlife management plan for their own property, as well as share what they have learned with others through a variety of outreach programs.
