**OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY:** Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers \$1.00-\$3.00 lower. Stocker steers and steer calves \$4.00-\$8.00 lower. Stocker heifers and heifer calves \$3.00-\$5.00 lower. Trade moderately active at lower levels. Demand moderate. Conditions comparable to last week but higher percentage of attractive feeders in light flesh. Weigh-ups average to gaunt early, average to full late. Light supply of calves were mostly new crop. Spring pastures doing well but moisture needed to continue this condition. Slaughter cows \$2.00-\$3.00 lower; slaughter bulls \$5.00-\$1.00 lower. Packer demand fair to moderate. Edge also off replacement stock with demand for these moderate at best. Receipts this week 13,833; last week 11,618; last year 14,922. Supply consisted of 89 percent yearlings over 600 lbs.; 7 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 4 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
