She received her answer immediately — she was arrested. Predictably, she was found guilty and sentenced on June 6th to pay a \$100 fine. She defiantly refused to pay, at that time, or ever. But the real surprise in this footnote to history is that the judge allowed her to go free, fearing that if he pressed the sentence she would press her case — all the way to the highest court in the land if necessary.

**POTATO AND WATERCRESS SOUP**

- 4 to 5 potatoes, peeled and diced
- 4 cups cold water
- 1 bunch watercress
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1/2 cup milk
- salt and pepper to taste

Boil potatoes in water until tender. Drain, reserving water. Press potatoes through a sieve and return to pot with reserved water. Chop watercress (reserve a few sprigs for garnish), add to pot, and cook 5 minutes. Add butter and milk. Heat until warm, season to taste, and garnish with watercress. Good warm or cold.

Makes 4 to 6 servings.
