The general sessions will be held in Eisenhower Auditorium on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings at 7 p.m., and the final sessions are Thursday morning at 9 a.m. More than 1,250 FFA members, advisors, and guests are expected to attend.


The convention will feature three general sessions. Tuesday evening will be a celebration of the 65th FFA anniversary as well as recognizing Honorary Keystone Degree recipients, state officer parents, and a special presentation by hypnotist, Dr. Jim Wand. Wednesday evening the featured speaker will be Tyler Grandil, National FFA western region vice president. We will also be recognizing state citation winners, proficiency recipients, listening to the state chorus, and paying tribute to the FFA Foundation sponsors. Thursday morning will feature the recognition of the state winners ir the 26 contests as well as the election of the 1994-1995 state officers.

Other highlights will include participation in one of 26 career skill competitions, including prepared and extemporaneous public speaking, parliamentary procedure, land judging, and agricultural mechanics. Recreational activities provide members time to interact with fellow FFA members from across Pennsylvania. The public is invited to attend any of the general sessions.
