OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY: Compared to last Tuesday: Feeder steers and heifers steady to \$2.00 lower. Few steer and heifer calves as well as all stockers steady. Trade and demand moderate. Flesh conditions slightly thin thru moderately fleshy. Weigh-ups gaunt to full, mostly average to full. Quality of supply plain thru attractive. Slaughter cows steady to \$2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls steady to \$1.00 lower. Receipts this week 12,450; last week (Holiday shortened) 4,070; last year 13,928. Supply consisted of 90 percent yearlings and few calves over 600 lbs.; 6 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 4 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.


