DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN SUMMARY FUND BUYING ON THE BOARD AND CONTINUED WEATHER CONCERNS DROVE GRAIN AND SOYBEAN PRICES HIGHER. WHEAT 1 TO 4 CENTS HIGHER. CORN 3 TO 5 CENTS HIGHER. SORGHUM 4 TO 20 CENTS HIGHER. SOYBEANS 12T 14 CENTS HIGHER. SPILLOVER STRENGTH FROM CORN AND BEAN PITS TURNED WHEAT PRICES HIGHER. SOFT RED WINTER WHEAT HARVEST IS ACTIVE IN SOUTHEAST AREAS BUT RAINS CONTINUE TO DELAY CUTTING IN MANY AREAS OF TEXAS AND PARTS OF KANSAS. EXPORT DEMAND HAS IMPROVED FOR WHEAT ESPECIALLY PURCHASES FROM SRI LANKA AND JAPAN. CORN AND SOYBEAN PRICES MOVED SHARPLY HIGHER ON WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR ABOVE-NORMAL TEMPERATURES AND BELOW-NORMAL RAINFALL FORECAST FOR MIDWEST. ALTHOUGH RAIN MAKES GRAIN SUNSHINE IS NEEDED TOO, GO FIGURE. THIS FORECAST IS THRU MID-JULY WHICH WOULD AFFECT IMPORTANT GROWING STAGES IN CORN DURING THIS PERIOD.
