

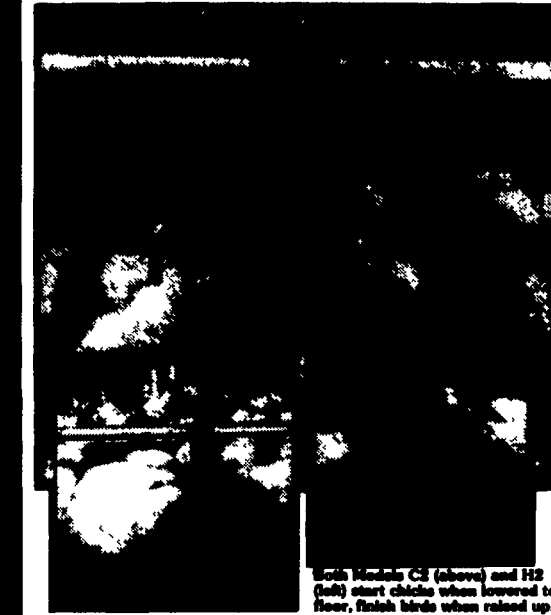

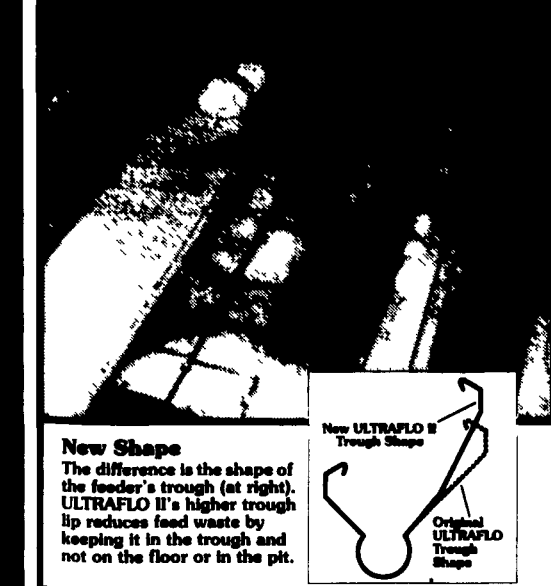


Both Models C2 (above) and H2 (left) start chicks when lowered to floor, finish birds when raised up.


