The program, conducted by Adventure Pals' Miss Jean, will

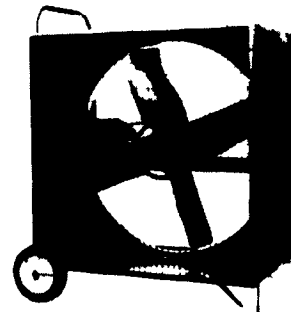
feature songs, puppets, clowns, food and gifts.

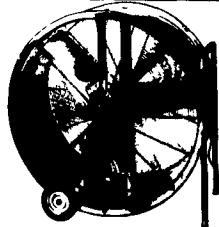

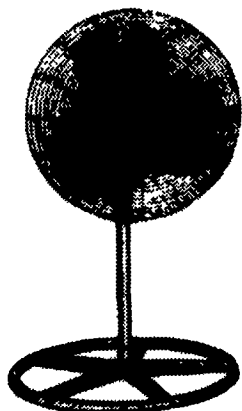

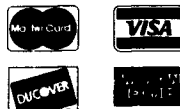
