

Fellowship Of Christian Farmers Forms Pa. Chapter

MANHEIM (Lancaster Co.) — Pennsylvania's first chapter of the Fellowship of Christian Farmers (FCF) International was recently formed. Plans are already under way for an Aug. 20 picnic near Wrightsville.

After several years of hearing much talk about forming a Keystone State chapter, Donald L. Hershey of Manheim took the matter into his own hands this spring. All that was needed was a little gentle inertia, because the interest was there.

Some 75 farm and agribusiness people gathered in a church near Manheim to learn about the fastest-growing farm group in the United States. At that meeting, a steering committee volunteered to

start the chapter, elect officers, and lay plans for the future.

The national organization, headed by Wilson Lippy, Hampstead, Md., includes more than 10,000 farmers and agribusiness persons. It's dedicated to building and strengthening the Christian faith among farm families and friends in agriculture. It also undertakes many mission projects to disaster-stricken U.S. farm regions, and to Mexico, South America, Africa, Europe and the Commonwealth of Independent States (formerly the Soviet Union.)

More than 900 Pennsylvanians are already affiliated with the national association.

The steering committee elected Hershey as president; Robert Coe

of West Grove, Pa., vice president; Bob Grant of Cochranville, Pa., secretary; and David and Phoebe Bitler, Fleetwood, Pa., treasurers.

On Saturday, Aug. 20, from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., the southeastern Pennsylvania chapter of Fellowship of Christian Farmers will host a picnic at Samuel Lewis State

Park overlooking the Susquehanna River near Wrightsville, Pa. (East of York near U.S. Route 30).

The program includes inspirational music, uplifting thoughts, and a pork barbecue. Participants should bring lawn chairs.

Reservations are required by Aug. 8 so that food needs can be planned. Cost: adults, \$3; children

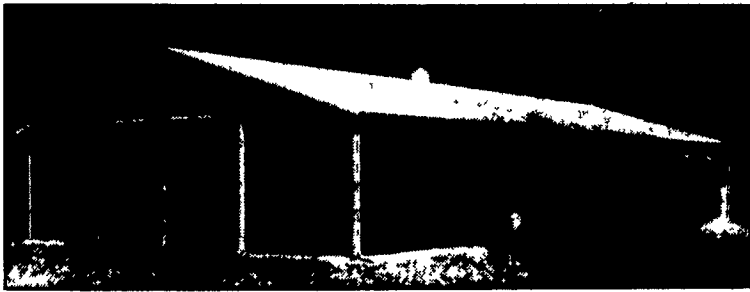
age 5 to 10, \$2; children under five, free. A free-will offering will also be taken to help cover expenses.

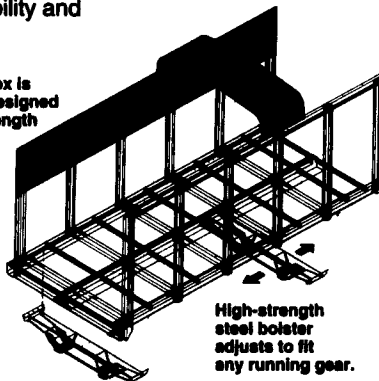

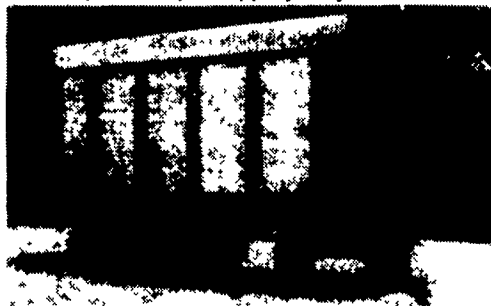

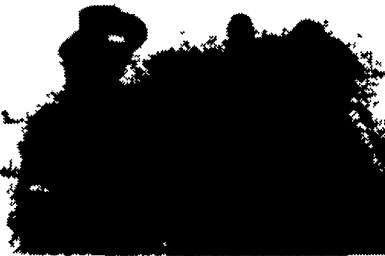
