### Hayes Receives Big E Award

WEST SPRINGFIELD, Mass. — The New England Fellowship of Agricultural Adventurers presented Willis H. Hayes of Wilbraham with the annual Agricultural Adventurers Award at a meeting of board of directors of Eastern States Exposition recently. Hayes is past president of Eastern States Exposition.

Since 1953, the fellowship has honored outstanding leaders in New England agriculture. A special committee, appointed by the trustees of Eastern States Exposition, selects its annual fellows on the basis of innovation, pioneering, and lifetime dedication to agriculture.

Hayes is a native of Connecticut and a graduate of the University of Connecticut. He served as a teacher of vocational agriculture in New York State prior to joining the Farm Credit Banks of Springfield, Mass. He stayed at Farm Credit Banks 34 years, retiring in 1974 as vice president and secretary in order to devote more time to The Big E. A trustee of Eastern States Exposition since 1957, Hayes served as president from 1971 to 1985.
