Hatfield Quality Meats purchased the grand champion hog for \$1.80 per pound.

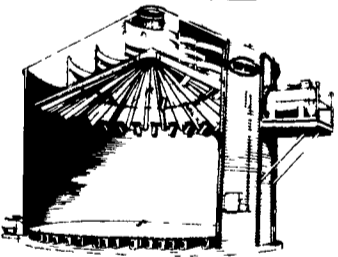
