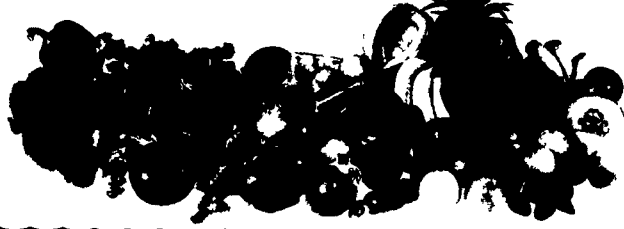

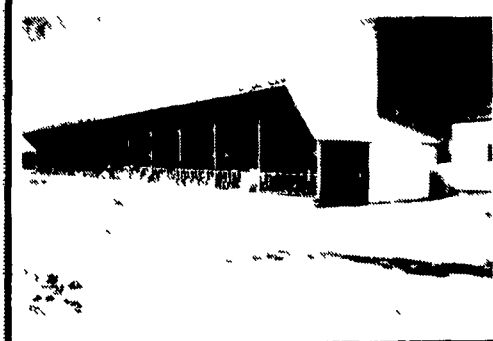


SLATTED FREE STALL BARN

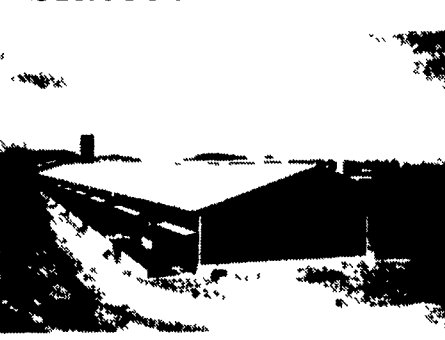
Slatted Hog Barn

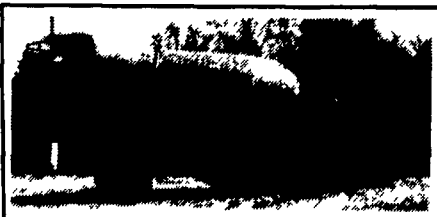
