Oklahoma City, Okla.

Compared to last week: Feeder cattle \$1.00-\$2.00 higher. Holiday shortened receipts met good demand with moderately active trading. To few calves to test markets. Quality of feeder supply average. Weigh-ups average. Flesh conditions light to medium. Slaughter cows \$1.00-\$1.50 higher, bulls steady to \$1.00 higher. Slaughter cow demand good as packers in need of numbers to begin kills in post holiday period. Receipts this week 2,325; last week 13,950; last year 2,245. Supply consisted of 89 percent yearlings and few calves over 600 lbs; 3 percent calves and few yearlings under 600 lbs.; 8 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

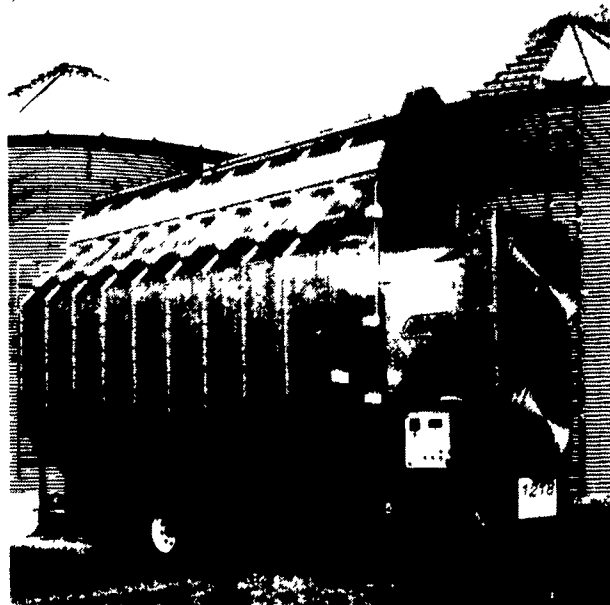

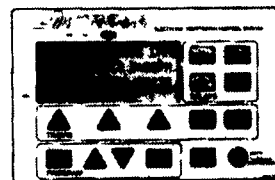
