

HPOCA Goes Rough And Tumble

KINZERS (Lancaster Co.) — The Hart-Parr Oliver Collectors Association moves east this year for their National Summer Show. Rough and Tumble Engineers Historical Association will be the host show during their 46th Annual Threshermen's Reunion, August 17-20, at their show grounds in Kinzers, 12 miles east of Lancaster.

Kinzers is in the heart of the beautiful, bountiful farm lands of the Pennsylvania Dutch Country. Visitors to this most complete Steam and Gas Show in the East should allow plenty of time to see the tourist attractions in the area. Oliver did a lot of business over the years in the territory that is served by this Show. Visitors can expect to see one of the largest

groups of Oliver Wheel and Crawler Tractors and equipment ever assembled. The association is planning to show the smoke and steam of a Farquhar Pennsylvania stem traction engine, a rugged Ann Arbor baler with a wooden bale chamber, and one of the early New Holland balers built by Oliver dealer, Arthur S. Young. Featured will be Cletrac and

Oliver Crawler tractors and the versatile little green giant HG-68 will be the feature tractor. Jim and Fulton Owensby will have many of their nicely restored Cletracs there, including Jim's Cletrac 80. Jerry Leib plans to bring his big OC-18. Landis Zimmerman will display his hefty OC-156. Shuey Sales and Service will bring their OC-96 and their pretty all white Orchard HG. There will be many more crawler and wheel tractors, both agricultural and industrial, on display.

Sam W. White, Jr., retired president of the Oliver Corporation will be there at showtime. He will be the keynote speaker at the banquet at Harvest Drive Restaurant on Saturday evening. The huge Ford New Holland manufacturing complex is just seven miles north of the Rough and Tumble Show grounds. Special arrangements have been made for plant tours to be conducted Thursday, August 18 and Friday, August 19.

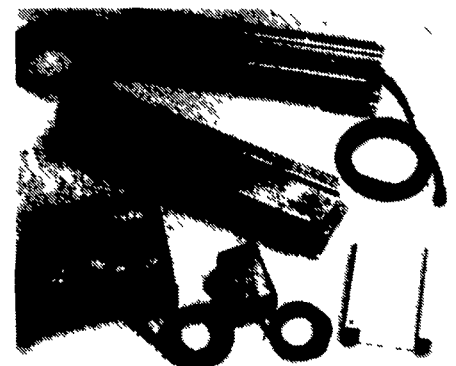
