Compared to last week: Feeder steers and steer calves \$2.00-\$3.00 higher. Feeder heifers and heifer calves \$1.00-\$3.00 higher. Demand remains excellent with cornbelt buyers continuing to dictate the market. Quality of the supply plain to attractive. Weigh-ups varied from gaunt to full, mostly average to full. Feeder cattle in light to medium flesh, end moderately fleshy. Conditions similar to last week. Strong weight yearling cattle dominating sales as feeder market has improved some \$5.00- \$6.00 to its best level since end of April. Slaughter cows weak to \$1.50 lower. Slaughter bulls \$.75 lower. Demand fair to moderate cows and bulls. Receipts this week 12,375; last week 12,870; last year 11,300. Supply consisted of 84 percent yearlings and few calves over 600 lbs.; 13 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 3 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

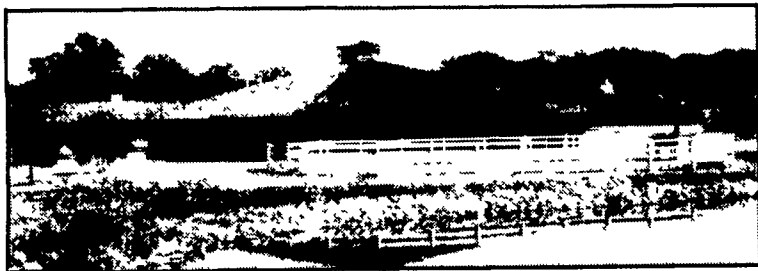
