plies for this year. I feel the portable milking unit used in conjunction with intensive grazing is another example of a dairy farmer getting more efficient, using environmentally sound practices and producing a higher quality product. I'm not asking you to agree or disagree. I'm not asking you to believe in my theory or practice. I am asking you to give me a chance to prove that a portable milking unit will work and work better than a conventional milking facility. Give me a temporary permit for one year and I will demon-

strate my theory. This herd will create little environmental damage if any, will be healthy requiring little veterinary treatment and have the lowest somatic cell count in the state.

The issue of farmers becoming more efficient will prove out in the profitability of using this system when compared to traditional methods of dairying. If the theory presented does not prove to be true you (the health department) have the power to end this practice at any time.

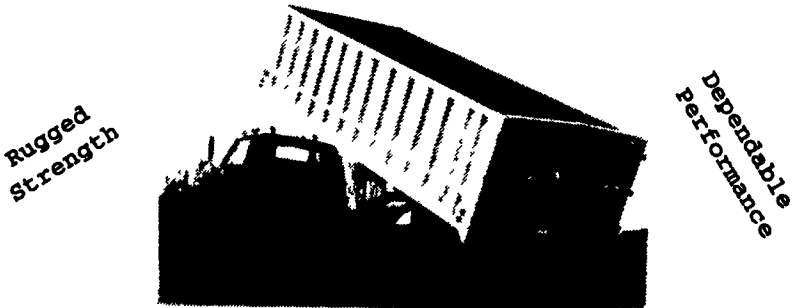

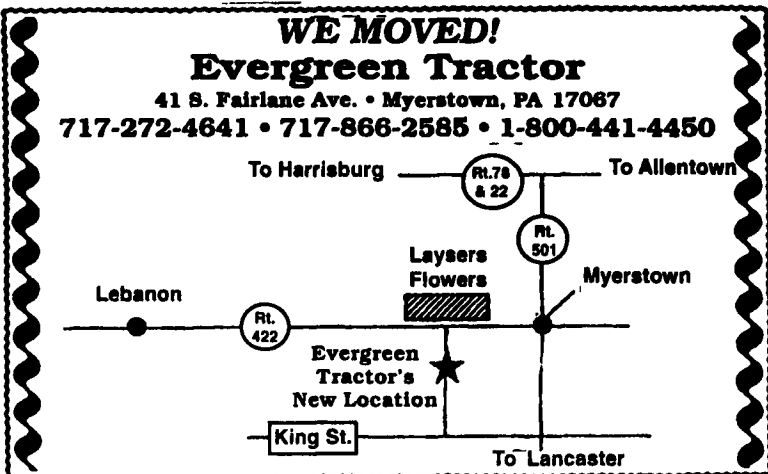
