August 14 - 20, 1994

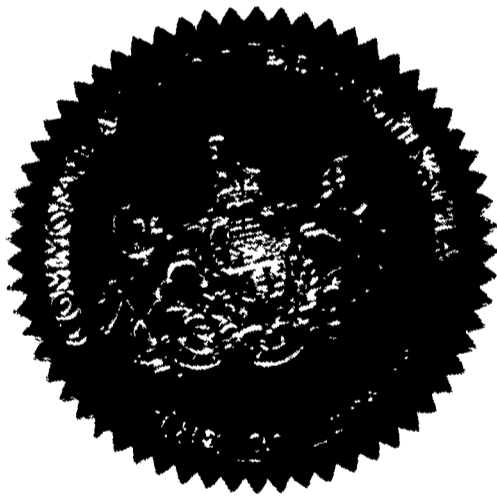
Pennsylvania's dairy farmers have achieved national recognition for their efforts, which now put the Commonwealth fourth in the nation in milk production. In addition, the dairy industry makes up more than one-third of Pennsylvania's leading economic sector.

The Dairy of Distinction Program was developed as a tribute to the hard work of our dairy farmers. A team of judges works to select the most attractive dairy farms in Pennsylvania, rating them for neatness, maintenance, and roadside appearance. Five-hundred-fifty-five farms have won Dairy of Distinction honors since the program was started in 1986.

In recognition of the dedication and commitment of our dairy farmers, I, Robert P. Casey, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby proclaim August 14 - 20, 1994, as DAIRY OF DISTINCTION WEEK in Pennsylvania.
