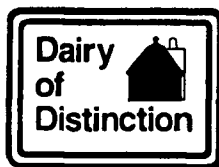
PERRY

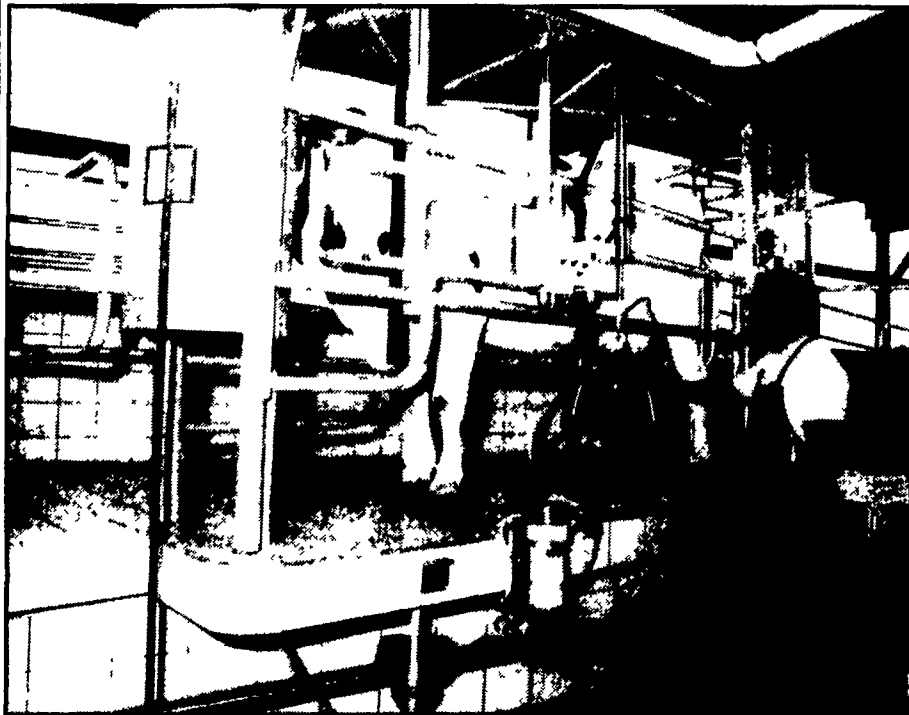

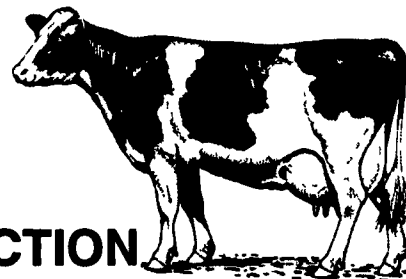

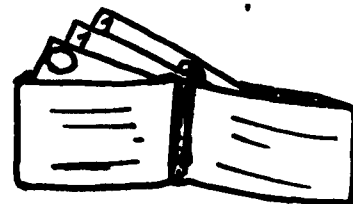
