Overall demand good with active trading.
However, buyers were not as aggressive as
past two weeks and more able to enact
proper discounts and credits where applic-
able. Quality and conditions similar to last
week. Weigh-ups in complete range of
gaunt to full. Feeder cattle in light to
medium flesh, few fleshy. Quality of sup-
ply plain thru attractive. Slaughter cows
steady to \$1.50 lower; bulls steady.
Receipts this week 10,584; last week
12,373; last year 10,100. Supply consisted
of 83 percent yearlings and few calves over
600 lbs.; 14 percent calves under 600 lbs.;

and 3 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow
with weighted average weight and price in
parenthesis.
