# Farm Bureau's Fall Conference To Focus On Education

BINGHAMTON, N.Y. — New York Farm Bureau's annual Fall Conference sponsored by Farm Bureau Women, will explore how the state's agricultural industry can work together to increase the public's understanding about the industry.

The two-day session will be held September 29-30 at the Holiday Inn Arena in Binghamton. The conference will be held in conjunction with the Ag Teacher's Association and the New York Agriculture in the Classroom Program.

In addition to covering the challenging topic of educating the public about agriculture, conference participants will be treated to an upbeat talk by noted farm humorist Jane Jenkins Herlong. Hailing from South Carolina, it has been said that Herlong "weaves a rich tapestry of self-

empowerment through heartwarming examples, humorous anecdotes, homespun truths, and high-flying songs."

Other conference/speakers include the following: "The Power of Motivation and Importance of Critical Thinking," Robin Eubanks, workshop specialist; "ATANY Inservice-networking/Building Partnerships," Dr. Joyce Winterton, National FFA Partners Team; "State Issues Facing Education/Ag Education," NYFB staff; "Environmental Issues Facing Agriculture," NYFB staff; "Preventing Hearing Loss," Marylee Hill, N.Y. Center of Agricultural Medicine and Health; "Promoting Farm Bureau Women's Programs," Dr. Joyce Winterton; and "Networking-How Can We Work Together?," Patsy Perkins, professional trainer.

There will also be an opportunity to tour area sites, including the Phelps Mansion, a post-Civil War Victorian-style mansion; the Robertson Museum and Science Center; and the famous Boscov's Department Store. In addition, there will be an optional dinner on the second night involving an interactive mystery dinner theater, "Death is a Caberet."

The conference is open to young and old alike. It's a chance to get away for a couple of days of learning, fun, and relaxation. 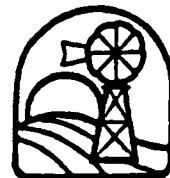
