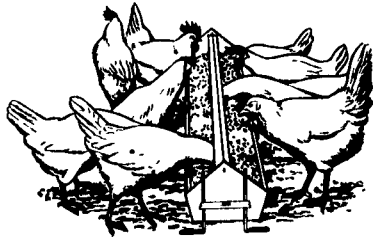

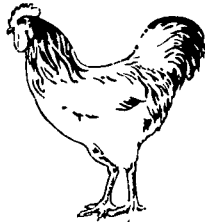
Prices were generally trending lower on large and heavier weights in the South Central region but unchanged elsewhere. Trade sentiment was mixed and barely steady, especially on heavier weights. Demand was fair to good, best where features were planned or in progress. Offerings were irregular from area to area. Loose eggs were traded at or below normal relationship to cartoned product. White shell heavy weight eggs were more available than either medium or heavy brown eggs. Breaking stock values were trending lower in some locations as offerings increased. Live hen offerings were adequate for processing needs.

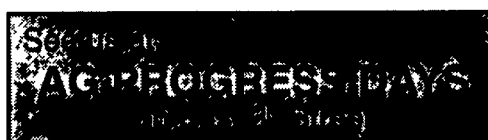

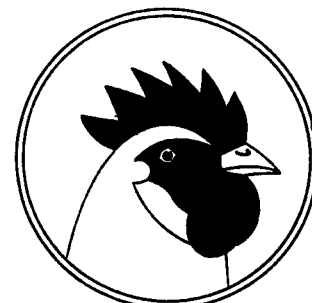
