

Braund Valley Captures Both Banners At Troy Holstein Show

TROY (Bradford Co.) — Braund Valley Farms captured the premier breeder and premier exhibitor banners in what Bradford County Extension Agent Tom Maloney described as a "very close race."

In fact, according to Maloney, only two points vaulted Braund Valley to the top over Mt. Glen Farm.

Senior, grand and supreme champion honors in the Holstein show were bestowed upon Miss Karma Logic, owned by Gen Rich Farms and Dave Page, of Columbia Cross Roads. The champion was a 5-year-old sired by Hanover Hill Logic ET.

Reserve senior and grand champion distinction was awarded

to Royal Haven Inspire Quill, a junior 2-year-old sired by Hanover Hill Inspiration and owned by Lynn and Bonnie Miller, of Towanda.

Junior champion honors went to Royal Haven Broker Queen ET, a winter calf owned by Lynn and Bonnie Miller and sired by Conant Acres JY Broker.

The reserve junior champion of the Holstein show was Maple Flat Encore Lilac, a summer yearling owned by Danielle Sparling and sired by Marcrest Encore.

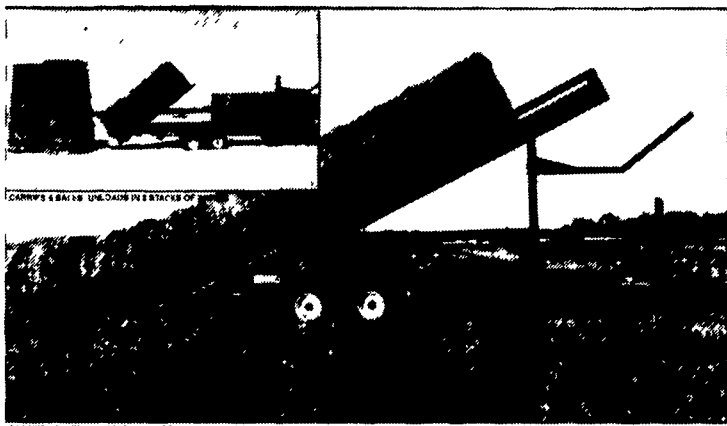

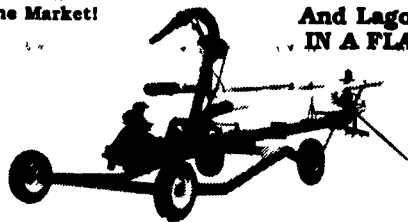
