Brian, 13, is the son of George and Kathy Stump, Shoemakersville. The gilt was obtained at at commercial sale in Manheim in April. Brian was reserve grand champion about five years ago at the Kutztown Fair Swine Show. Brian, who will attend grade 8 in the Fleetwood Middle School, will showing at the Oley and Reading fairs.

George Stump said that Brian, who once worked at a farm, picked the hog at the Manheim sale. He said that the six-year Berks County 4-H member knows what traits in a potential swine championship to look for.

Fitting grand champion went to Anita Manbeck and reserve to Kristen Haas. Grand champion showman was Joseph Schick and reserve was Grant Lazarus.

Breed show champions were Hampshire, John Strawbridge: champion Landrace went to Grant A. Lazarus III; and Yorkshire champion went to Stephen Wessner.
