**OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY:** Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers \$1.00-\$3.00 lower. Steer and heifer calves \$2.00-\$4.00 lower. Trade moderate. Demand fair to moderate. Quality of supply average to mostly plain with a predominance of Brahma influenced cattle. The quality was the plainest of any sale thus far this season. Flesh conditions light to medium. Weigh-ups average to full. Central and western Oklahoma very dry with forage limited. Eastern Oklahoma pastures in good to very good condition. Slaughter cows steady to \$1.00 higher; slaughter bulls steady to \$1.00 lower. 45% of cow supply was replacements.
