Hastings Receives Distinguished Member Award

NEWARK, Del. — Dr. Steven E. Hastings, a professor in the University of Delaware food and resource economics department, has been named a distinguished member of the Northeastern Agricultural and Resource Economics Association (NAREA).

Dr. Conrado Gempesaw, chair of the department and a member of the association, said, "We are extremely pleased that one of our faculty members received such a prestigious award. It recognizes Dr. Hastings' continuous and outstanding contributions to the asso-

ciation and his profession."

The Distinguished Member Award, one of the highest honors awarded by the association, was first given in 1977. Since then, only 16 other members have received it.

Hastings has served NAREA in

various capacities since 1972. His contributions include serving as president, two three-year terms as a member of the executive committee, appointment to the editorial board, chairing the nomination and the finance committees, and a term as secretary-treasurer. Under his leadership the association has grown and its records have been computerized.

Hastings teaches courses in resource economics and rural development. He is an active researcher in these areas and has written many journal articles,

experiment station bulletins and book chapters.

As a result of Dr. Hastings' efforts, his department was identified as a key resource unit in computer education at the university. Recently, he planned and supervised the upgrade of the college computer laboratory making it one of the most up-to-date computing facilities at the university.

NAREA honored Dr. Hastings at an awards luncheon on June 28 attended by more than 100 agricultural economists from the northeastern region.
