Compared to last Monday: Feeder cattle and calves \$2.00-\$3.00 lower. Trade moderately active after a slow opening. Demand light to moderate as a bearish atmosphere continues to permeate the cattle industry. Quality improved from last week and now plain thru attractive, many average and better. Weigh condition average, end full; this also an improvement for buyers. Fleah condition light to medium on feeders and mostly medium on calves. Feeder cattle have lost \$4.00-\$5.00 in two weeks. Steer and heifer calves are down \$4.00-\$6.00, with 400-500 lb. steer calves as much as \$10.00 lower in the past 2-3 weeks. Slaughter cows \$1.00-\$2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls \$1.00 lower. Packer demand fair. 436 cows and bulls sold; includes 55% replacement cows. Receipts this week 8,570; last week 14,464; last year 11,800. Supply consisted of 78 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs.; 17 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 5 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

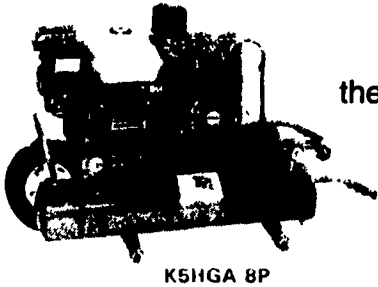

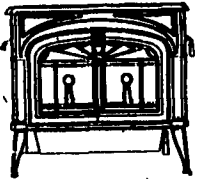
