UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre Co.) — Pennmore is a soft red winter wheat variety developed by the Pennsylvania Agricultural Experiment Station and released in 1992.

Certified seed will be available in the fall of 1994. The cross giving rise to Pennmore was made in mid-1970. The initial selection that became Pennmore was made in 1981.

After additional selection, breeders seed was produced and Pennmore was entered in the state

grain trials in 1987.

Performance has been outstanding in southeastern Pennsylvania where average grain yield was about 17-percent higher than that of Tyler and test weight was 5-percent better than that of Tyler. Plant height, maturity, and lodging resistance are comparable to Tyler.

Based on field observations, Pennmore has moderate resistance to leaf rust and moderate susceptibility to powdery mildew. Pennmore has very good milling

properties and good baking properties based on evaluations conducted at the Soft Wheat Quality Laboratory in Wooster, Ohio. Authorized seed classes will be breeder, foundation, and certified.
