

York 4-H Lamb Club Holds Show, Sale

THOMASVILLE (York Co.)
— A homebred Hampshire lamb earned grand champion honors at the York 4-H roundup for veteran exhibitor Matt Trostle.

The 15-year-old Red Lion shepherd captured the top award during the season's first roundup, held August 15 at Weikert's Livestock Buying Station.

Lebanon Valley National Bank was the winning buyer of the champion lamb during the round-up sale which followed, paying \$2 per pound for the 130-pounder.

East Berlin 4-H'er Mike Olson took the reserve champion title with his homebred Hampshire-Suffolk cross. The win will help

make his final year as a 4-H'er extra special for the 18-year-old senior club member.

Buyer of Olson's reserve lamb, at \$1.10 per pound, was Hoke Mills, Inc., Abbottstown.

Champion lightweight honors went to Maria Graybill, Hanover. Her 90-pound winner sold for 95 cents per pound to Walter Dunlap Livestock. Jennifer Flinchbaugh's champion medium weight sold to James T. Parlett on a 85.5-cent bid. The champion light heavyweight, exhibited by Adam Sellers, Thomasville, brought a \$1.10 final bid from Garrod Hydraulics, Inc.

A \$1.25 bid from Walter Dunlap Livestock bought the reserve

champion light heavyweight, exhibited by Tabitha Ebersole, York. Heather Bankert's reserve champion lightweight earned the Red Lion 4-H'er a \$1.30-pound bid from Herbst's Garage. Reserve champion mediumweight honors went to Dave Olson, East Berlin, with buyer Winter Garden Salad Company the final bidder at 95 cents.

Average on the 23 head of roundup lambs was \$1.26 with the champions, and \$1.25 without the champions.

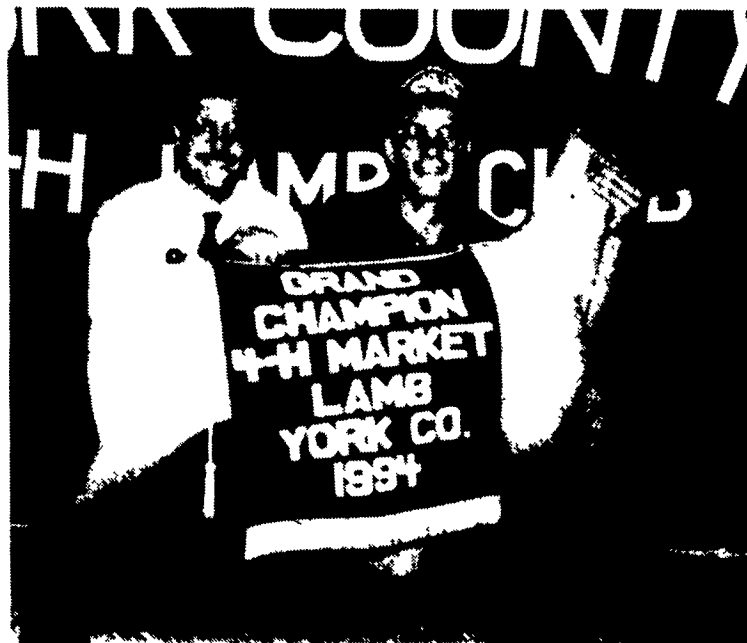

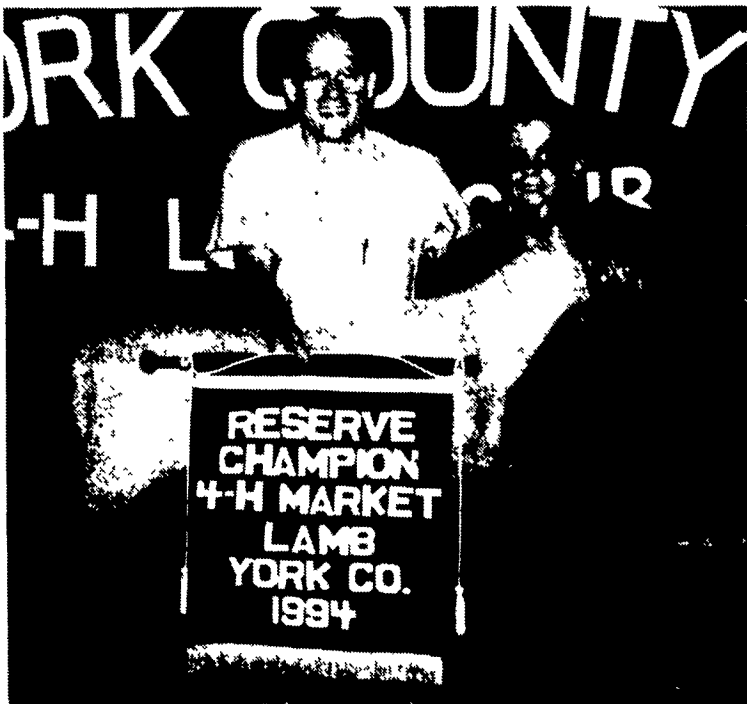

Danny Kenamond of Mifflinburg showed Globe-Run-F & N Aerostar Lana, a junior two year-old to the reserve grand championship and was named the 4-H grand champion.

J & K-Vue Prelude Josie, shown by Michael Zimmerman of Millmont, was first place intermediate Holstein calf and was the open and FFA junior champion.

Den-Ann Counselor Tara, shown by Jason Wolfe of Lewisburg, was the reserve junior champion of the open show and the 4-H junior champion.

Judge Curtis Day of Shipponburg saw 126 entries in the show.

In the Ayrshire division, Brad's Rambling Rose, shown by Daniel Rishel of New Columbia, was the grand champion of the open show and the FFA show.
