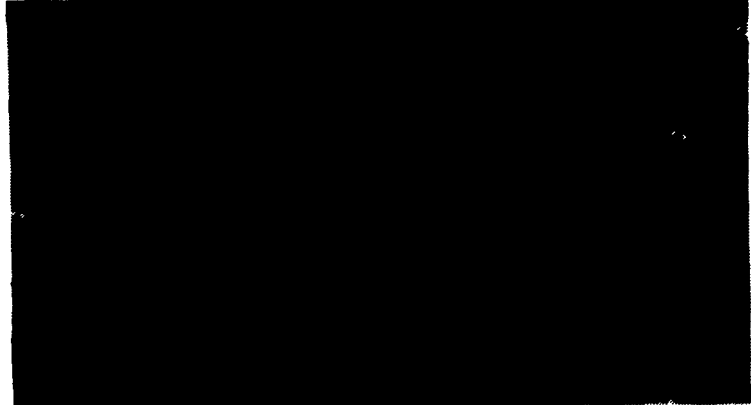

The grand champion and best owner bred animal was a junior 2-year-old sired by Schultz Performing Legend and the reserve champion was a 7-year-old Jersey sired by Four Springs High C-ET. 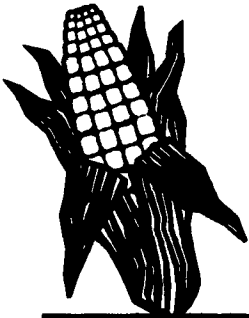
