The smaller than usual show had 91 Holsteins, 20 Jersey and six Brown Swiss dairy animals shown by the 4-H and FFA exhibitors. There were no Guernsey,

Milking Shorthorn or Ayrshire animals this year.

Although it was rumored that folks were concerned about Bovine Viral Dysentery (BVD), extension agent Brown said. "In fact they (cows) are probably in better shape this year because people are looking for it (signs of BVD)," said Brown, adding that farmers are supposed to isolate their animals after every show and some haven't been doing it. He said that sometimes isolating their animals comes down to having, or not having enough space to do it.

This year there's a greater sense of caution among the farmers, he said, but no BVD cases have been reported in Somerset County, he said.

Snider also judged showmanship after an emergency kept invited judge, Bernida Gable, of Bedford away.

Show exhibitors came from the Berlin-Brothersvalley FFA Somerset Area FFA, Brotherton Belles and Beaus, Dairydells, Maple Valley, Milkshakers, Milksquirts, Mountain Springs, Supermilkers, Valley and White Oak 4-H Clubs.

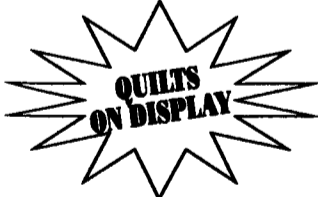
