Computer Record Keeping Workshop Set

LANCASTER (Lancaster Co.) - If you own a computer or are thinking about purchasing one, and want to use your computer for your tax and some production records. Lancaster County Cooperative Extension has a new program for you.

A workshop series is intended to familiarize the farm manager and/or his designated record keeper with a farm financial recordkeeping system that uses low-cost, flexible, easty to use computer software. Participants are encouraged to bring their personal computers (PCs) to the Lancaster Farm and Home Center for use during the second and third work-

The location for the workshop will be the Lancaster County Farm and Home Center, downstairs. The instructor will be Prof. Larry Jenkins, farm management specialist.

The dates and times for the workshops will be September 22 at 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. This general information session will be open to anyone and will not be limited to any number of attendees. The session will discuss computerization of farm records in general, systems available, need for accurate production and tax records, etc.

On October 20, workshop sessions 1 and 2 will be held. Session 1 will be 10 a.m. to noon. Session 2 will be 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.

Session one will include getting acquainted with the software: installation, setting up accounts and categories, the entry path, and learning about the register and practice sessions.

In session two, you will get acquainted with the accounts. You will learn about inventory entry, accounts payables and receivables, capital purchases, personal or household expenses, sales, credit, assets and liabilities.

On October 27, workshop sessions 3 and 4 will be held. Session 3 will be 10 a.m. to noon. Session 4 will be 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.

In session three, you will get acquainted with the following reports: transactions, credit, cash flow, accounts payable and receivable, profit and loss reports as well as balance sheet generation and income tax management re-

Session four will revolve around data entry practice. You will work with accrual adjustments, credit reports, farm operating income and expense reports, and first-of-year and end-of-year inventory adjustments.

Lunch will be on your own, so there will be no cost for the workshop. Preregistration is requested for sessions 1, 2, 3, and 4 because

limited meeting space is available. Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. This workshop is limited to 20 participants because of the large amount of individual assistance that will be given, so register early to assure yourself a place in the
