## 4-H'ers Share York Fair Junior Steer Honors

York Co. Correspondent YORK (York Co.) — For the fifth year in his 4-H beef exhibitor career, Shawn Waltimyer took home the banner and revolving trophy awarded annually to the York Fair's junior market steer champion.

Waltimyer, 17, from Airville,

topped a field of two dozen entries in the popular market steer competition with his 1,295-pound Maine-Angus crossbred, winner of the heavyweight division.

Placing reserve in the winners' circle was 4-H exhibitor Suzanne Bishard of York. Her South Branch-bred Angus, dubbed "Calvin after the comic-page boy,

weighed in at 1,230 pounds and took top honors in the light heavyweight division.

In the Junior Beef Prospect Steer show, a competition held for lighter steers, champion honors went to Tammi Grubb, Hanover. "Romeo," a 1,135-pound Angus, had earlier earned the heavyweight division title.

Reserve champion honors in the Prospect show went to Jodi Dutrey, Dallastown, whose 1,040-pound steer was named mediumweight class winner.


