

# ADC Members Receive Additional Payments


SOUTHAMPTON (Bucks Co.) — Atlantic Dairy Cooperative members recently received nearly \$1.8 million in additional payments, the equivalent of 5 cents per hundredweight.

The additional payment was based on the cooperative's "good earnings" for the 1994 fiscal year, according to Robert M. Dever, chief executive officer. Atlantic's net margin totaled \$7.3 million, with more than \$574 million in sales.


