

Hess Receives Scholarship

UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre Co.)— Jayne N. Hess, a senior majoring in agricultural science in Penn State's College of Agriculture Sciences, has been selected to receive the Zeneca Ag Products/American Agricultural Editors Association Scholarship.

Hess is the daughter of John and Bonnie Hess of Gettysburg.

The \$2,000 scholarship is sponsored by Zeneca Ag Products, a leading manufacturer of crop protection products, to support the American Agricultural Editors' Association by investing in the future of agricultural journalism.

Penn State was selected to receive the scholarship at the

AAEA annual conference in Chicago in October 1993. Lynn Bell, a 1987 Penn State alumna in dairy science and editor of Jersey Journal, won a drawing to choose which institution would receive the award. A faculty committee associated with the college's agricultural communications minor selected the specific recipient.

To be eligible, candidates for

the scholarship must show both aptitude and interest in print communications and be pursuing a career in the agricultural industry.

Hess co-edited the 1994 edition of Penn State's Dairy Science Club magazine and helped edit and prepare the American Dairy Science Association 1993 final report. She also

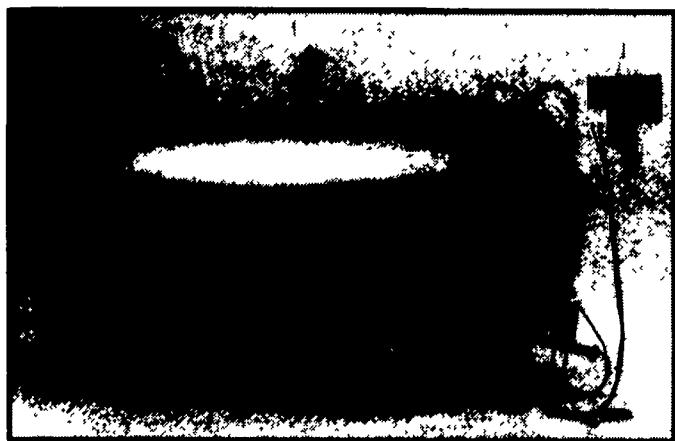
has worked as a 4-H summer assistant for Penn State Cooperative Extension in Adams County and was Adams County Dairy Princess in 1991.

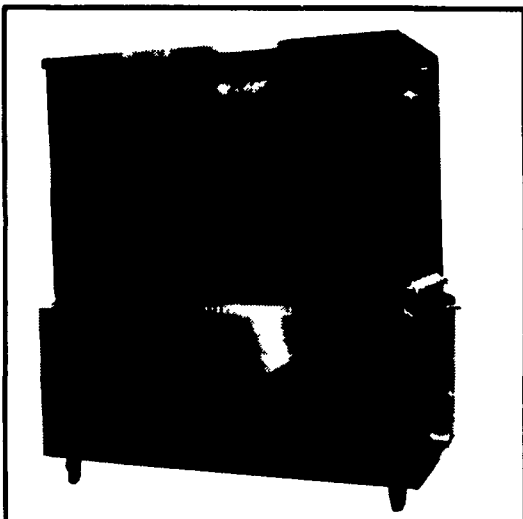
