

NASDA Elects Boyd Wolff Vice President

NEW ORLEANS — Pennsylvania Agriculture Secretary Boyd E. Wolff was recently elected to serve as vice president of the National Association of State Departments of Agriculture (NASDA) during that organization's annual meeting in New Orleans.

Wolff, a long-time member of the NASDA Board of Directors, previously served as secretary-treasurer of the organization and has been chairman of NASDA's Dairy, Food and Drug Committee.

"It's an honor to serve in a

leadership role for an organization like NASDA," Wolff said.

"During this annual meeting we've examined some key issues for American farmers - issues like pushing the U.S. Congress to remove the prohibition on the interstate shipment of state-inspected meat. That issue is very important to small business owners and agri-businesses."

Delegates to the NASDA annual meeting also discussed governmental jurisdiction for wetlands issues, enforcement of Worker Protection Standards (WPS) for agricultural pesticides,

and private property rights.

In addition, NASDA unveiled a unique national approach to generate rural jobs through an effort to commercialize new products and new uses for agricultural materials. That effort is a joint project between USDA's Alternative Agricultural Research and Commercialization Center (AARC) and NASDA's Research and Education Foundation.

NASDA is a nonprofit association of public officials representing the commissioners, secretaries and directors of agriculture in the 50 states and four territories.

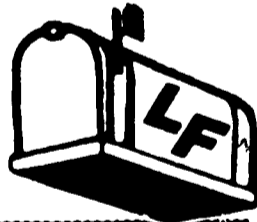
