Ask Greg Hess, who picked up champion FFA sale lamb on Wednesday at the West Lampeter Fair. "Buying quality lambs" is the reason Greg gave to taking home the trophy for "Cleo," his light heavy-weight Suffolk spring lamb at the sheep show.

The Suffolk is "a lamb that I think exhibits what we're looking for as far as style," said Melanie Horchler, show judge, who raises purebred Suffolks and Corriedales in Lebanon. Horchler, who judged last year's sheep show at the fair, praised the lamb for its "natural muscling from end to end."
