The 1,312-pound reserve champion heavyweight, exhibited by Phillip Baer, Glenville, sold to Ray L. Myers Construction, Inc., with a bid of \$1.05. Reserve champion lightweight, the 1,237-pounder exhibited by Kelly Myers, Thomasville, sold on a \$1.25 bid to Wildasin Bedliners.

Farmers' Bank and Trust, Hanover, purchased Sara Hoke's reserve champion medium weight, bidding \$1.15 for the Glenville 4-H'ers 1,139-pound champion medium weight, bidding \$1.15 for the Glenville 4-H'ers' 1,139-pound steer. A 95-cent bid from Glatfelter Agribusiness Insurance purchased the 1,042-pound reserve champion lightweight from exhibitor Tammi Grubb, Hanover.

Average sale price on the steers with the champion was \$1 per pound, and without the champion, 89 cents per pound.

A hog shown by Kelly Myers was purchased by Hoss's Steak and Sea House and given back for resale benefitting the meats judging team. East Berlin Pharmacy bought and turned back for resale a lamb sold by Shanna Daugherty.

Dr. Gerry Stinson purchased two lambs to donate back for the meats judging team benefit, one each from sisters Cindy and Buffy Dehoff. A second lamb of

Buffy Dehoff's was purchased by Rishel's Landscaping Service and donated to benefit the 4-H exhibition area. Waltmyers' John Deere Sales and Service purchased a lamb sold by Tabitha Ebersole and donated it back to be used for the county 4-H lamb club annual banquet.

Nearly \$60,000 was generated by the junior livestock sale, benefitting participating junior exhibitors and various York County 4-H and junior livestock educational events and activities.

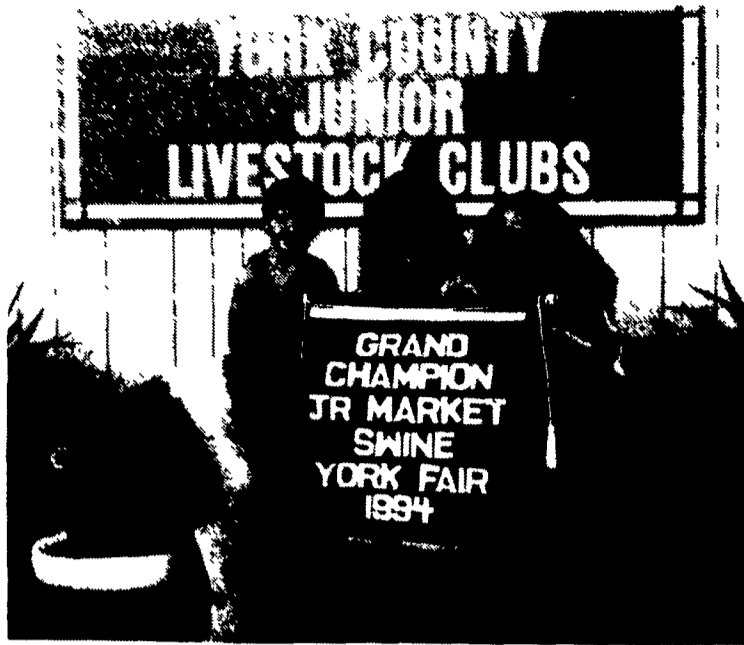
Dairy Farmers Meeting
