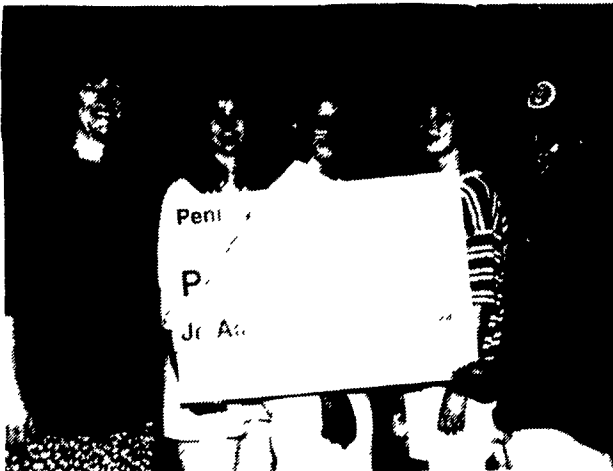
4-H'ers competed against more than 1,000 other members throughout the state in judging, shooting sports, presentation, learn and earn, and fashion review.

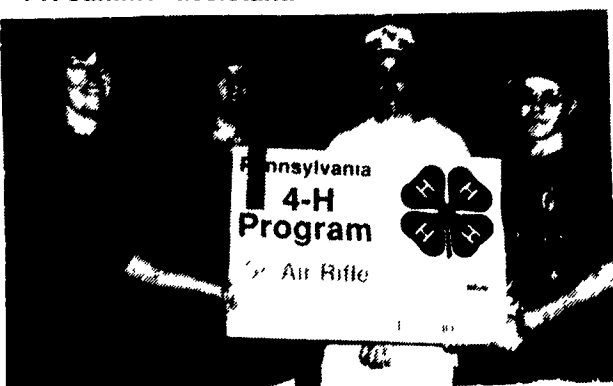

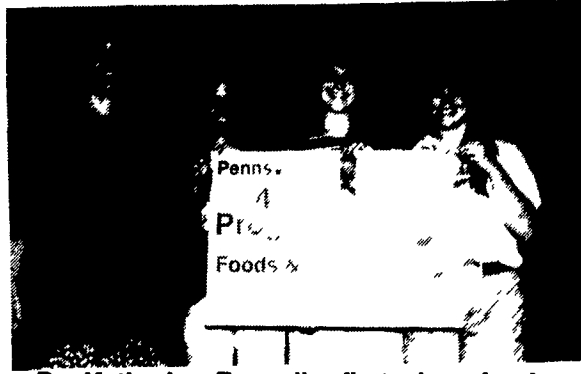

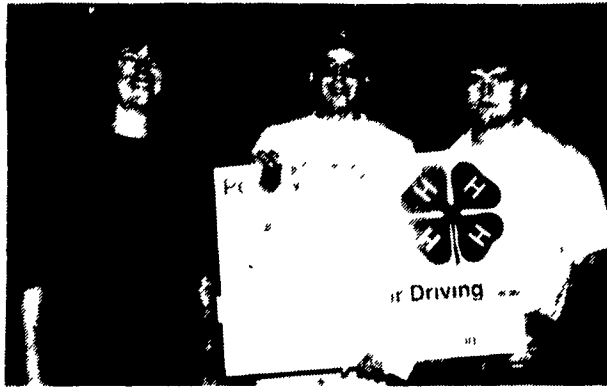

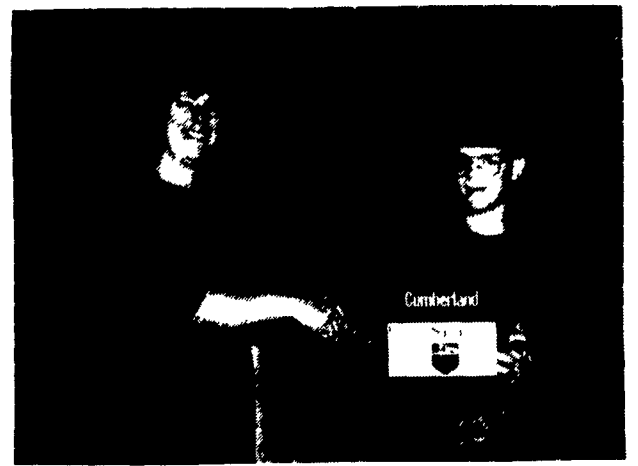
