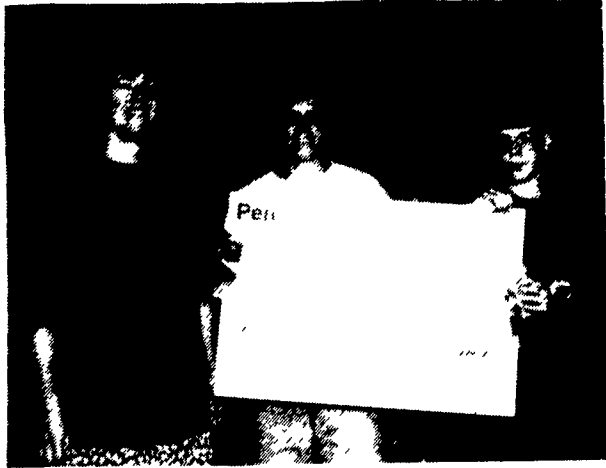


4-H's Compete At Penn State
