HONESDALE (Wayne Co.) — Wayne County dairy cattle enthusiasts recently held several county level shows at the county fairgrounds in Honesdale.

In the Holstein show, the grand champion cow was a senior 3-year-old shown by Dan Conlogue, of Con-Acres in Pleasant Mount. The reserve grand champion was shown by Shelly Woodmansee, of Jericho Dairy, in Lake Como.

Theron LaTourette, of Honesdale, showed the junior champion and the grand champion Holstein bull.

David Harvatine, of Thompson, showed the reserve junior champion.

In the junior colored breed shows, the judge was Ronald Trostle, of Red Lion. He placed 51 head of Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, and Jersey cattle, and also judged showmanship.

Ron Curtis was grand champion showman, while Jacob Chyle was reserve grand champion, both receiving a show halter.
