

KILE Beef Show Results Reported

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — The Keystone International Livestock Exposition just closed its doors on the 38th annual edition, with 4,000 head of livestock on hand for the competition and a share of \$217,369 in premium money.

The annual show, held at the 16-acre Farm Show Complex, is sponsored by the Pennsylvania Livestock Association, Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, and Pennsylvania Farm Products Show Commission.

There were 590 head of beef entered in the Exposition, a competitive showcase for North America's top livestock breeders. The Shorthorn Show was designated as a Point Accumulation Event and the Limousin Show was a Medal of Excellence Show. Winners by breed were:

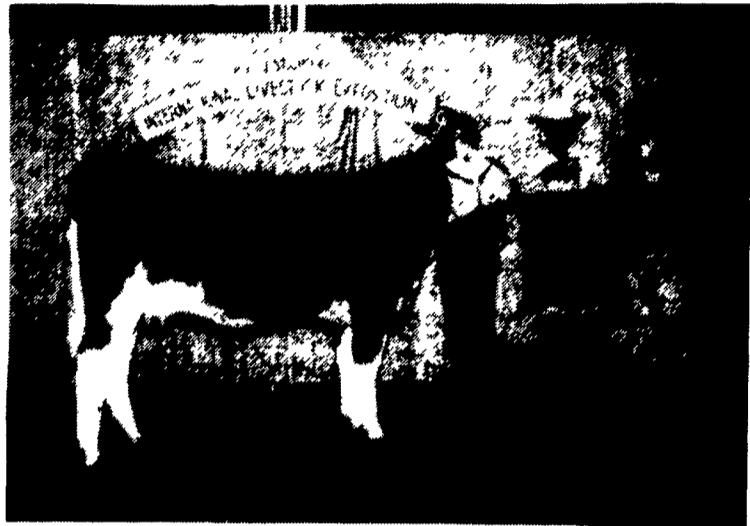

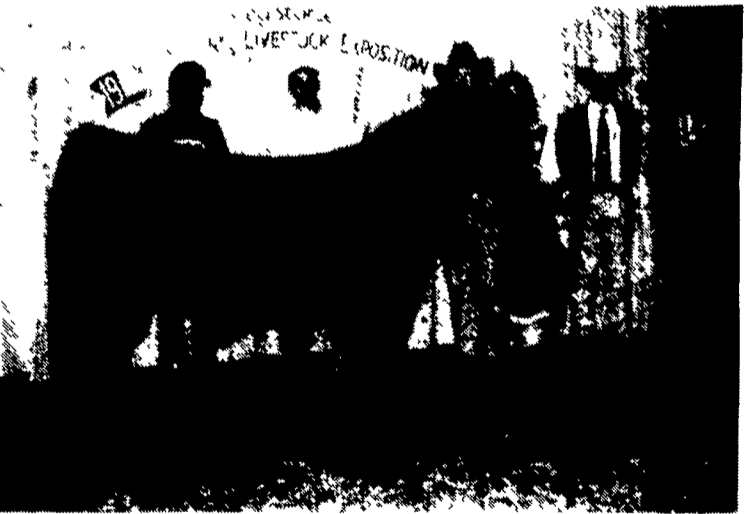

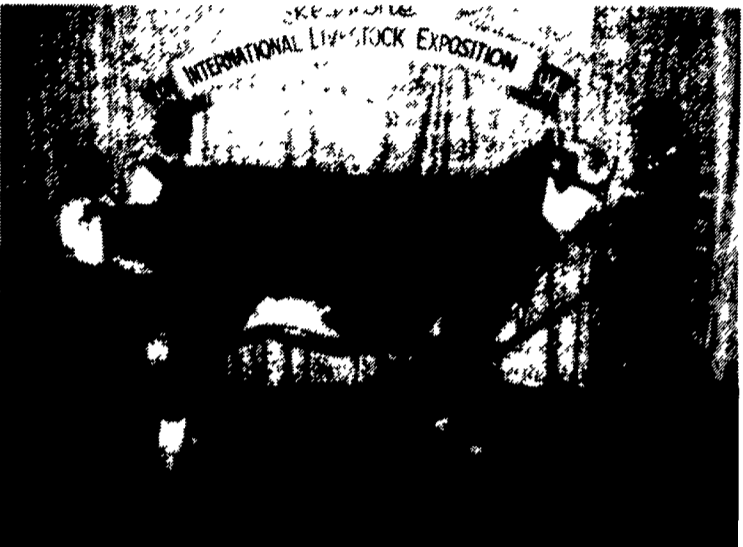

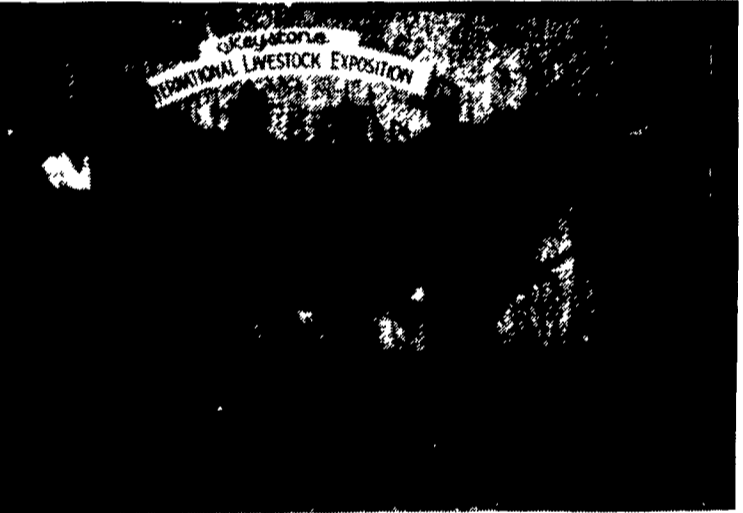

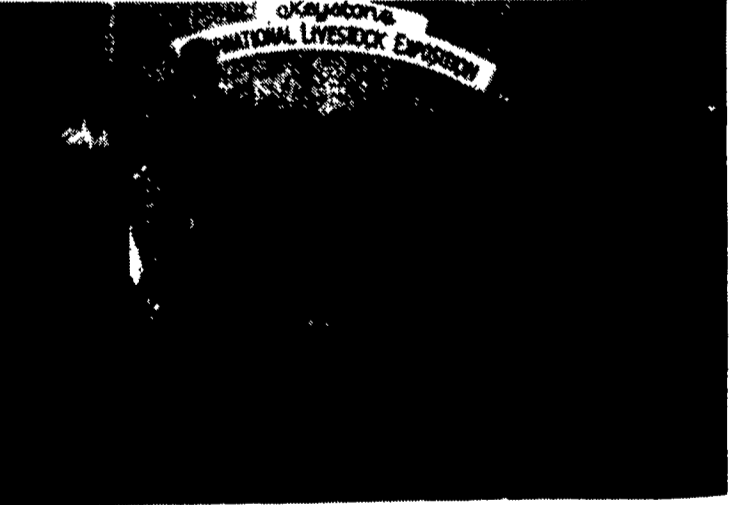
